On February 18th and 25th we will collect a special offering for Week of Compassion. Week of Compassion is the relief, refugee and development mission fund of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in the United States and Canada. Week of Compassion seeks to equip and empower disciples to alleviate the suffering of others through disaster response, humanitarian aid, sustainable development and the promotion of mission opportunities.

This year's Week of Compassion offering theme is **MORE THAN WE CAN IMAGINE!** It's easy to feel overwhelmed when we look at all the areas of need in God's world: there is hunger, sickness, and injustice in so many communities. It is easy to feel that we are too small, too insignificant, to make a difference. We can feel trapped by hopelessness and fear that there is little we can do to truly make an impact. But there is hope! Better yet: we are that hope! For, as the Apostle Paul writes, *"by the power at work within us,"* God is able to

"accomplish abundantly more than we can ask or imagine" (Ephesians 3:20). Archbishop Desmond Tutu put it succinctly when he wrote, "we are the agents of transformation that God uses to transfigure [God's] world." As Christians, we know that we are part of God's answer to the need in the world!

- ... after the doctor says, "I'm sorry, but there's nothing more we can do."
- ... after the nursing home director shakes your hand and says, "Welcome to your new home."
- ... after the last child honks the horn, waves, and drives away—and the house suddenly seems empty.
- ... after the gavel goes down, the handcuffs go on, and your loved one is led away.
- ... after the baby arrives, demanding more of you than you ever dreamed possible.
- ... *after* you find a pink slip with your final paycheck.
- ... *after* your family and friends have heard your story one too many times, but you still need to talk it out.

Stephen Ministers are the "After People." They are ready to come alongside you—or your friends, neighbors, coworkers, or relatives—and provide comfort and support for as long *after* as needed.

The FCC Book Club is an interdenominational group meeting monthly on the first Thursday of the month, 4pm at the church (unless otherwise noted).


