Micah 6:6-8

With what shall I come before the Lord and bow down before the exalted God?

Shall I come before him with burnt offerings, with calves a year old?

Will the Lord be pleased with thousands of rams, with ten thousand rivers of olive oil?

Shall I offer my firstborn for my transgression, the fruit of my body for the sin of my soul?

The Rev. Bruce A. Barkhauer, Minister for Faith and Giving, writes ...

It is clear that at the end of the day, what God wants from us is not our stuff, but our "whole heart". Bulls numbering in the thousands and running rivers of oil are not the sacrifice that God desires, but rather our willingness to abandon all other loyalties and claims that clamor for our attention, in favor of one: God. A commitment that does not get measured by the gold standard of empire's wealth, but rather one of the simple turning of life toward the priorities of the Realm. Do justice, love mercy, and walk humbly with God. It seems so simple, but we know the opposite to be true. It is easier to just swipe our debit card and contribute to a cause. In the church, it often feels safer to ask for money than to ask for the changing of a life's priorities. It is not that offerings are inappropriate, but they should flow from the heart of relationship and manifest themselves in more than temporal gifts.

The real issue is moving from the transactional to the relational. Such a move is at the core of Stewardship. Stewardship is about more than money. It is a whole life response to the abundant generosity of God. A generosity that is gauged by more than what we hold in our bank accounts. Stewardship is about the care and management of creation, the observation of Sabbath and the care for the precious gift that is our own life. It is about sharing the good news of the gospel by inviting others to join us at an always expanding table of grace. Faithful stewardship is about the intentional and impactful deployment of our spiritual gifts. And yes, it is about our stuff. But more than that, it is a way of giving that flows from the heart in concrete ways in response to what God has already done.

It is also about our stuff. Lest we forget, the bible is concerned about money at two basic levels: First, our relationship with money (and what it can provide); Second, how we use what moves through our sphere of influence toward advancing the principles of the Kingdom of God. Do we use what we have been given to make a difference or to make ourselves more comfortable? Do we own our stuff, or is it the other way around?

At the end of the day, our Stewardship Campaign includes asking for money – a commitment, a tithe- to support the mission and ministry of our congregation. But it's about more than just money and our need as a church to receive it. Stewardship comes from a deeper, more spiritual place ... it comes from our "whole heart", our desire to live into our faith, to share our faith, to be the image of God, to be the feet and hands of Christ in our homes, in our places of work and school, and in our communities. May we give graciously and generously.




